Hi, kids!





- 🌐 Many popular books have Christian themes in them, like the Chronicles of Narnia and Lord of the Rings.
- 🌐 People all around the world celebrate Christmas (even if they don't celebrate it as Jesus' birthday) and sing Christmas carols that talk about Jesus and the night he was born.
